Sightreading Tips

Become a great sightreader by practicing these skills:

- Know which notes belong in what key, and where those pitches on the page translate to string positions.
- Examine the music for obvious trouble spots.
- Look at the time signature, rhythm, and key.
- Read ahead and think in terms of patterns rather than individual notes.
- Don't stop when you make a mistake.
- Practice scales and arpeggios, as these are the building blocks of most pieces.
- Work on sight-reading every time you practice.
